

Note : Sufficient attested copies of SSLC or equivalent, Plus Two and Degree marklists and certificates should be kept by the candidates.

All students are to wear the prescribed uniform in the College campus.

Attendance

The minimum requirement of attendance in a semester is 75% for each course.

Examination

- There will be external examinations at the end of each semester as prescribed by the University
- Internal Examinations and other quality verification procedures will be conducted by the College from time to time.

Withdrawal

A student once enrolled for a course is expected to complete the same. If he/she withdraws from the College without taking transfer certificate, he/she will have to pay fees for the period his/her name remains on the rolls.

Evaluation and Grading

The evaluation scheme for each course shall contain two parts:

(1) Internal assessment (2) External examination.

Of the total marks, 20% is taken from the internal assessment, and the remaining 80% from the external examination.

General Rules of the Office

The College office functions from 8.30 am to 4.00 pm on all working days.

- Application for any certificate should be addressed to the Principal in the prescribed form.
- If a student desires to obtain a certificate (transfer, conduct, study, bonafide etc.) he/she shall apply for the same in the prescribed form to the college office and collect the same after a working day.
- All fees must be paid as per the notified date and format.

Guidelines for Students

- All students are answerable to the Principal, Staff and other College authorities for their conduct and behaviour.
- College begins at 8.55 am with attendance followed by Morning Assembly and closes at 2.30 pm.
- Students are expected to be regular and punctual for classes, curricular and extra-curricular activities.

- Attendance at all activities organized by the College is compulsory.
- Students are required to wear their identity card and uniform at all activities of the College, unless otherwise permitted.
- Any loss or destruction of the College property and furniture will be chargeable individually or collectively as the case may be.
- Notice Boards provide regular communications for the students.

GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION

The candidates who are seeking admission to the Degree/Post Graduate Courses must be registered in the University Single Window Admission Registration site and download CAP ID Registration Form.

Fifty percent of the seats will be filled on the basis of merit through the Single Window System. Fifty percent is reserved as Management Quota. Number of seats allotted are as follows: BBA - 50, B.Com. C A - 60, B.Com. Finance - 60, B.Com. Banking & Insurance - 40, BCA - 36, B.Sc. Mathematics - 24, B.Sc. Computer Science - 36, B.Sc. Psychology - 24, B.A. English - 24, M.Com. Finance - 15 and M.Sc. Electronics - 12

Applicants who seek admission through Management Quota should apply in the prescribed form available online and at the College office. They should also have the CAP Registration. After filling the CAP ID they must submit the filled form at the college office.

All selections are provisional and subject to confirmation after personal interview by the Selection Team and the scrutiny of certificates. Candidates who fail to report for the interview as per the prescribed date and time will forfeit their seats forthwith.

Admission Procedure

At the time of interview the applicant should be accompanied by the parent/guardian and must produce the following documents in original:

- Transfer Certificate from the Institution last attended.
- Conduct Certificate from the Institution last attended.
- Mark lists of SSLC or equivalent and +2 with 4 photo copies.
- SSLC, Degree Mark List and Provisional Certificate for PG.
- 8 passport size photographs.
- Community certificates for SC / ST / OEC / OBC students.
- Migration Certificate (Applicants coming from other Universities).
- Equivalency Certificate (Applicants coming from other Universities).

Once selected after the interview, the candidates will be enrolled on payment of the prescribed fees and submission of certificates. The selected candidates and their parents are required to read the Prospectus carefully and sign a declaration of compliance with the College guidelines before the payment of fees.
